**PUBLIC FOOTPATH B66 (PART), STOCKERSTON ROAD, GREAT
EASTON**

WITHIN THE PARISH OF GREAT EASTON

AND THE DISTRICT OF HARBOROUGH

PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2020

The above Order made on 23rd January 2020 will divert the part of Footpath B66, which extends from point "A" on the plan, situated west south-west of Stockerston Road at grid reference 48466 29338, in a generally south south-easterly direction along a corridor between hedges for a distance of approximately 50 metres to point "B" on the plan, situated off Stockerston Road at grid reference 48469 29334. The route to be diverted has no specified width.

The alternative route will extend from point "A" on the plan, previously described, in a generally east north-easterly direction for a distance of approximately 17 metres to point "C" on the plan situated at a junction with Stockerston Road and at grid reference 48468 29339. The new alternative footpath will have a width of 3 metres.

A copy of the Order and map has been placed and may be seen free of charge at Room 200 Main Building, County Hall, Glenfield, Leicestershire, LE3 8RA and the offices of Harborough District Council, Symington Building, Adam & Eve Street, Market Harborough, Leicestershire, LE16 7AG during office opening hours. A copy has also been sent to West Langton Parish Council. Copies of the Order and map may be purchased at a cost of £15.

Any representation about or objection to the Order may be sent in writing to me at the undermentioned address quoting reference RJ/HTWMT/4428 not later than 5th March 2020. Please state the grounds on which it is made.

If no such representation or objection is duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Leicestershire County Council may confirm the Order as unopposed. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representation or objection which has not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.
